The Saint Bede Knitting Group consists of about 20 women who meet in the Saint Bede conference room to knit and crochet every Wednesday from 10:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. Our mission is to provide handmade hats, sweaters, scarves, mittens, lap robes, blankets, etc. for needy recipients. Among the recipients of our work are the HOPE Pregnancy Center, Mary Immaculate Hospital in Newport News, Catholic Charities, the Williamsburg Heritage Humane Society, Glenmary missions in Appalachia, Hospice House of Williamsburg, the Refugio mission in Ecuador, the VA hospital in Hampton, and Avalon, a shelter for women and children in Williamsburg.

We display our work in the Commons after all Masses on one weekend every other year so the parishioners may view some of our finished products. These items are not for sale as they are slated for donation to our charities.
